RANGE**

M. Athalie Range was a Bahamian civil rights activist who defied Jim Crow segregation by registering her son in the whites-only public school in Liberty City, Miami. In the 1960s, Athalie became the first Black person to serve on the Miami City Commission, from which she would later play an enormous role in integrating Miami's public school, and work to meet basic needs of the Black impoverished community in Miami. She is one of the women featured in the *Women of Color Against the War* series.
